DETAILS

Kickoff at Hook's Grill & Grog in the Treasure Ship
Registration will be from 6-8PM September 8, 2009
Entry Fee: \$400
No Frills (Bar will be open). Let's have some fun fishing!

Federal Size Limits:

Blue Marlin—99"

Note: Federal permit required for Tuna

Weigh Master: Scott Dicks: All fish to be donated to Salvage Santa (aka Mike Jones).

RULES

1. White Marlin and Sailfish will be catch and release only and will not be weighed or allowed at scale area.
2. All fish must be weighed prior to dockage.
3. Earliest Departure time: 12:01AM September 9, 2009.
4. No explosive devices allowed—Only rod and reel permitted.
5. Weigh-in dock is located at the Treasure Ship. Weigh-in starts at 7PM and closes at 10PM (No Exceptions!).
6. Prize Category Order
 - a. Blue Marlin takes all. Tournament minimum size for Blue Marlin is 101".
 - b. If no Blue Marlin is caught then Tuna, Wahoo, and Dolphin are eligible.
7. Division:
 - 1st Place: Heaviest Blue Marlin
 - 2nd Place: 2nd Heaviest Blue Marlin
 - 3rd Place: 3rd Heaviest Blue Marlin

If only 1 Blue Marlin caught: 100% of entry fee.

If 2 = 60%—40% of entry fee.

If 3 = 50%, 30%, 20% of entry fee.

If no Blue Marlin is caught the prize money division will be the same as for Tuna, Wahoo, and Dolphin(Less Tournament Expenses).

ALL FISH MUST BE IN EDIBLE CONDITION. MUTILATED FISH WILL NOT BE WEIGHED!
